AUSTRALIAN SUBMARINE AGENCY GIFTS AND BENEFITS DISCLOSURE

1. Under the Australian Public Service Commission Gifts and Benefits Reporting Guidelines, agency heads must publish a register of gifts and benefits accepted where the value of the gift or benefit is greater than \$100 (GST exclusive), and received during the reporting period.
